Male 1	What do you think we take...it is open land.
Male 2	It is all open area.
Male 1	There is nothing on it but gravel and sand. They came and took some before...we gave them permission...
Male 2	There is something else there. Two villages, a village not from comrade Ezzat's side, it has villagers living in [Inaudible].
Unidentified Male	Sir, it's for the guards...
Male 2	There is a village before you arrive to Nesab from the west going left. The village has villagers; I don't know what they are considering the area for [Inaudible].
Unidentified	Several people talking [Inaudible]
Male 2	No, no, it is outside the area - that's what I mean.
Male 2	They are considering going through a checkpoint.
Male 1	They are considering the terminology for the special commission. They are using "Structure" [TC: the words in quotations are spoken in English and the speaker is explaining the meaning in Arabic] it means structure or structures so the observation tower "Box" guard shack or guard box is considered a structure they are describing it in detail. They describe "Presidential Library" and "Multi Story Building", which means a multi level building, "building office", "villa's", "garage", "warehouse" it means warehouse all this is included within the guards they are counting all this...
Male 2	Not in the 100's but in the 10's
Male 1	All this has been counted and we approved it. For the specified area, we have a direction as we have discussed your Excellency, we have this complex and the rest is clear, Al Radwaniya has a fence.
Male 2	This complex means, this palace and that palace, these two complexes, it means one block of it for cars, etc., and garages that belong to the tenants. There are houses of citizens, schools, and kids. It is all one block; why don't you come and check it out?
Male 1	No, when they see it, they will ask for this specific area, the presidential palace.
Male 2	He cannot get into this area, which is between two palaces located on both sides of the area. The team can get in; they can get in and when they do you will see the guard. When you come in you have to come in where the guard is or else you are not getting in.

Male 1	This location, when you come in from the Palace information area and enter the parade street, Mawkeb street, it is clear from the Hanging Bridge to [Inaudible] but here you have Ibn Sina and the Khuz room, there is no need.
Male 2	No this is outside the area.
Unidentified Male	Outside? There is no wall, where does it...
Unidentified	[TC: Inaudible, several people talking at the same time.]
Male 2	Make them get in from there, Mawkeb Street the entire east side of the Mawkeb Street, there are palaces and the west side [Inaudible] to the intersection palaces too but from the gas station to Ibn Sina inside Ibn Sina.
Unidentified	[TC: Inaudible, several people talking at the same time.]
Male 2	No, no it is on Mawkeb Street.
Unidentified Male	Everything is on Mawkeb Street; Zakhoura is on Mawkeb Street.
Unidentified Male	This is where we will put Mawkeb Street, it is going to be a landmark; every building on the right or on the left.
Unidentified	[Inaudible]
Male 1	Our fence is on Mawkeb Street
Unidentified male	So the separation is al Zakhuri to the gas station Sir. If we go up there to the check point Ibn Sina our guys will be behind the fence
Male 1	We will draw a wall from right Ibn Sina to...
Male 2	Abu Ziad, when you came in where did you enter? When you come in from your right towards the Palace, you cross it this way and you come behind the gas station, it will be on your right and then you are on Mawkeb Street... all this is the gas station, the information and Ibn Sina and all these houses...but everything across from the gas station, Zakhoura, to get to Mawkeb Street this is within Mawkeb Street.
Male 1	So your Excellency, tomorrow, there is no need to visit the sites. We come in and meet for an hour with your Excellency and we bring an engineer so the questions are clear for them and for us [Inaudible] so we can know where the limits are only Al Radwaniya.
Male 2	Al Jebeil and then you come in on what is al abed and the...

Male 1	We did not count the exterior that is the protection force, then how do we get out?
Male 2	Where do we get them out? What do you mean get them out?
Male 1	Meaning we get them out of the presidential area.
Male 2	How do they get in? Yes. How do they get in?
Male 1	Are they inside the area?
Male 2	No inside the area means on the same street, we do not have anything outside the area, meaning when you come in from Makhoul and you go up this is the protection building and then on your left it becomes Al Abed and the street continues towards the hill for a short distance which leads to the maintenance area.
Male 1	But as they say it does not have anything to do with the location, presidential residence, the palace and the perimeter and this and buildings and this Army sensitive area, this is all talk about what we don't need.
Male 2	But this is not the military you have to understand. I go and sit in Al Abed? I will go in one of those buildings. I will stay in Tarek meaning if I am there and they did not see me, the protection guys will go and kill them because the protection guys will. What got them in from the other side? OK, so who are you guys, how did you get in? We have a clash in the story and they know it, they know it but they want to see it with their own eyes so they can see it.... meaning what is this small building, guard post? OK this means that they have to hit every existing guard post and I calculate that on this principle, meaning I did not calculate correctly, this is a palace for guests for history and I don't know what for... I am in the valley sleeping in a tent; they want that subject... al Makhoul is the limit of the area.
Unidentified	[Inaudible]
Male 2	No, the truth is they did not see a real checkpoint. How is it that only I can use a checkpoint not far away, what do I need more than a checkpoint? I need a room either 2 ½ x 2 meters with a bathroom - what is going to happen in reality, in reality, it boils down to checkpoints, it's all about checkpoints...
Male 1	So your Excellency we count on you on to direct them on how to conduct themselves.
Male 2	Yes, but what I discussed with you is different than what I told them.
Male 1	[Inaudible] Every location where the limits are, we told them the first

	time that the presidential location is big or small that it has a fence and we specify [Inaudible]. Now I need a location that does not have an external fence like the Al Radwaniya that is here, this is clear now (inaudible) Tikrit has a fence.
Male 2	Yes, Tikrit has a fence and the location is clearly fenced.
Male 1	When they go with them, they will ask for the location of the presidential palace, they will classify this is a Palace, this is a meaning...
Male 2	Maintenance such as this is the palace and these are houses providing maintenance to it.
Male 1	Ok this is the team that I suggest.
Male 2	And who are they?
Male 1	Omar Rashid the chief of the working team.
Unidentified	[Inaudible]
Unidentified Male	Yes.
Male 2	Abu Ziad is going to explain to them, he is going to get into a technical discussion with them. Please come and explain what this is for? What do you use it for? ... When they see the location! They will say this is the main dividing line of the location, this is the housing complex of the area are these are the limits of the complex. Estimate the distance and mark it down.
Male 1	Mr. Johnny, General Khodr and myself will go, this is a big thing; I need someone who can guarantee and who knows the way and how to argue among the people I know who worked on the team...
Male 2	This is a principal location Abed has to go. He will go with them, the visitors are coming to visit a presidential compound, an escort won't be like Abed meaning he knows all the details and he can handle it, take Omar Rashid.
Unidentified Male	Sir, the ones that are going to contribute a lot...
Male 1	The arrangement, Mr. Minister, in a delicate manner...the exaggeration and intimidation. Like this he can have a clear idea and I can sit down with him and discuss in detail...we are going to propose to him several things; he is going to tell me this is presidential. That is not presidential, no, I am going to tell him this is used for this purpose of clarifying with him, as far as I am concerned, the special commission which is confusing

	me.
Male 2	Makhoul we can get all the checkpoints from outside.
Male 1	Excellent
Male 2	We start entering the checkpoint instead of being inside we will have it from...we move it where the intersection is between the two streets; the upper intersection or further the intersection is from here the second intersection that goes down to the lake area from inside.
Unidentified Male	The water, meaning these two streets.
Unidentified	[Inaudible] Several people talking.
Male 2	In this condition we can be there at the checkpoints not in this way. Question - is it by day or by night?
Male 1	During the day.
Male 2	Meaning during the day they will go there, how are we going to go on that street, it is only one street they are going to be there how do we get in on one street?
Male 1	No, right, of course we will have the inspection guard units, we will know where they are and from where they left. In the north we will know and the special security units will know they are heading to Tikrit, they arrive in Tikrit, when they pass Tikrit they are going to Al Makhoul. This we are learning from experience, between Tikrit and Makhoul the distance is 70 km, so we will know when they leave.
Male 2	We know that is a real complication, there is a complication... we do not need to divulge our position. I will tell them to please come in... this is what we have... we are going to move them during the week, take the entire Makhoul area...we don't want to give up our position and don't need to... the targets that we want them to deploy...we exhaust them so the real targets get lost ...
Male 1	And also they are going at night; this is the only time in their lifetime that they are coming.
Male 2	What do you think Abu Ziad? We cannot tell them not to go at night.
Male 1	Your Excellency, we decided to move everything [Inaudible].
Male 2	No, we are just saying that these guys are visiting and we have to tell them that this location is presidential. Where does it start and where does it end?

Unidentified Male	Sir, what I mean if we say we divide the land from here and from here and we have buildings left here we have to show a presidential location....
Male 1	Yes. From the sensitive locations.
Male 2	From the exterior of the presidential location the ones that definitely are not classified presidential.
Unidentified Male	We divide it from the presidential location and include it into the sensitive areas and not the positive areas and when he comes in, this guy Annan, he is the Secretary General.
Male 2	It is possible to give part of this to Annan when he gets in? Is he Anan or Annan?
Male 1	Annan.
Unidentified Male	No it is with the AA.
Male 1	Annan.
Unidentified Male	Annan with an A.
Male 2	Yes.
Unidentified Male	Sir [Inaudible] due to the fact that it is a part of the presidential compound and to the service of the citizens we will have special search area [Inaudible] we have to have a special way to search [Inaudible].
Male 2	No Abu Ahmad. We want to make them fail at the last minute, squeeze them to the end. We have to create situations where the Special Commission will go search for one time, the Special Commission, not the team that is coming... now at the same time I want two inspections to be simultaneously conducted; one for the things that we are going to ignore in the special locations the Special Commission will search only once. For example, Makhoul will tell them it is one street - how is it? People are visiting, the command is there, or so and so is there, or going out or coming in or the command is coming in or their guests. How do you say [Inaudible] this street no one comes in or goes out and if there is a car leaving there will be an incident...please come in... You want to make sure that there is nothing contrary to the allegations. This is from this point to this other point; the limits of the special inspection inquiry they will come in at the same time and we finish and....

Unidentified Male	The Secretary General's commission?
Male 2	The Secretary General's commission will start from here and will end there I am thinking this way I am thinking this formula...
Male 1	Sir, regarding this location that is attached to the presidential compounds but is outside the presidential area, he is saying that there is an understanding to search the sensitive locations which is backed by France, China, and Russia and additionally by Ambassadors of the permanent countries on the Security Council to the teams that are going to visit these locations which means that when they come in...
Male 2	These are subjects we are going to hand it to the French, meaning when we give it to Annan this is for our relation with the French... no, no we say it is for France and when he leaves we summon the French Ambassador and we tell him this is our flexibility, the other areas that are considered presidential will stay on the formula of the Special Commission for one time search the others also one time simultaneously....
Male 1	Sir, let me tell you how the commission thinks. Their thinking is following the presidential compounds, and this Special Commission is going to handle it. It means they are diplomats, the Secretary General's commission. They are going to say so that your Excellency and the comrades in the picture, they are going to say if we decide to visit a second time the presidential compounds with the same formula and the same teams we are going to argue that...
Male 2	What they are going to say is something we are not going to agree to.
Male 1	Another thing is that the area adjacent to the presidential area is connected. That is their target, to search it continuously by the Special Commission on the basis of sensitive areas, such as the ambassadors of Russia, China, and France, when they want to....
Male 2	No, on the same basis of the sensitive areas and the special commission the formula that France suggested but the searches are only conducted once for the same time that we agreed upon.
Male 1	Yes.
Unidentified Male	Sir...
Male 2	Yes, comrade.
Unidentified male	Are you going to comply with...[Inaudible] this inspection more than [Inaudible].

Unidentified male	The same thing...
Male 1	No, what I am saying is what they might say.
Unidentified male	We answered this question, we answered a logical question [Inaudible] meaning a scientific answer.
Male 2	What I am talking about is the last thing. I need a solution.
Male 1	Yes.
Unidentified male	So we solved the issuesso what did we solve?
Male 1	What I am saying now so that you are in the picture as far as the President, we present him with a final picture so he knows ahead of time what they are going to ask us.
Unidentified male	The question of exceeding more than once if there is a location that they cannot finish at one time.
Male 2	No, this is a real complication. It is not an excuse that will complicate our relationship with them. This time there is no crisis. Next time we will have a crisis - therefore we want a one-time inspection, we give them a location and we give it to them based on the formula that France suggested that will be simultaneous, meaning that they all start together and the formula of the presidential locations and the guest palaces concerned in this subject is within the formula that we suggested... [Inaudible]...this break up will make France feel comfortable and will eliminate the excuses.
Male 1	Sir, realistically, the three ambassadors from the Secretary General's team cannot be in two places at the same time.
Unidentified male	The other person....
Male 2	In the first place there is no way they can start inspecting the locations where the three ambassadors with the Special Commission team under the formula France suggested.
Male 1	Yes.
Male 2	Or they tell the Special Commission goodbye. Our commission starts now at the presidential compounds.
Male 1	Yes; yes meaning the operational division, if possible.
Male 2	Now initially when we suggested we gave them two months but they will

	finish in a week, one week.
Male 1	No sir, more than one week.
Male 2	I don't think they need more than a week.
Unidentified	[Inaudible]
Male 1	Because they are going to search the land, which will take time. Why don't we check with them.
Male 2	Ok, this area is underground, what does it detect? Metal?
Male 1	Yes.
Male 2	Fine, there is a place with reinforced concrete with metal.
Male 1	He doesn't mean the palace, he means the open land.
Male 2	Ha!! The lands.
Male 1	This, Sir we can summarize.
Male 2	Every step on the way they are going to get dirty, there are ruins, especially in Tikrit [Inaudible] and old cities.
Male 1	It is going to show once, twice... Sir, I asked the experts. There is the land inspection, they walk and inspect and the other way is more effective and faster which is inspection by helicopter but we don't have the resources they have to bring a helicopter and the proper equipment.
Male 2	No let them inspect by land, let them suffer let them get dirty every trip, cement, dust, this, that ...[Inaudible] and we will prepare the chocolate for them.
Male 1	Yes, we will prepare the chocolate for them.
Unidentified male	There is no objection [Inaudible]. Sir, it is just an opinion: the objective from this demand [Inaudible] in the technical terms in general but at the end it is going to mobilize the country. We are in charge of the operation at a minimum if Iraq appears to withdraw [Inaudible] not having an attack by itself constitutes an attack before the attack, meaning Iraq stretched it to the max and all countries are getting involved [Inaudible]. I reiterate and say that your path is known, your Excellency, in the movement and the presence a big part of it is going to be understood by them, and this is what your Excellency knows already and we have nothing to do with that. Let me say these positions are going to lead to worries, what are 30 days and then another 30 days? Why do we have to call it presidential? We can call it hotels, structures etc. For example Basra you can stay there, rest there...

Male 1	They are not interested in that.
Unidentified male	No problem, but he is considered on us.
Male 2	This time, they are not interested in Basra.
Male 1	They are not interested in Basra.
Unidentified male	Why?
Male 2	They know that I don't go there.
Unidentified male	Aha.
Male 2	Why don't we tell them why aren't you interested now, Basra isn't that a location?
Male 1	They did not even go there.
Male 2	I have paid attention to this a long time ago.
Unidentified male	Yes, I don't know! The subject is if we are specifying the time and the program in defense of the visit to the presidential location more than once in the time frame allotted.
Male 1	No, not within the time frame when they visit an area they finish.
Male 2	One day, two days, ten days.
Unidentified	[Inaudible]
Unidentified male	Like when they visited that building.
Unidentified male	Mr. President...
Male 2	They came back at the specified time.
Unidentified male	They went and took all the documents...
Male 2	That is o.k.
Unidentified male	Meaning during the specified time.
Male 2	We give them that flexibility [Inaudible] these two months consider yourself not here.

Unidentified male	We wash our hands.
Male 2	Consider yourself on vacation and sightsee around Iraq.
Male 1	But, Sir, we will follow up with comrade Taha, we will follow them step by step and I will tell them these are our known official locations.
Male 2	And they want to see that we have nothing.
Male 1	Yes.
Male 2	Ask them if they have any other requests to visit, if they say yes, let them.
Male 1	And we write a report.
Unidentified male	What do I say if they are asking if there is information?
Male 2	I would like to get your attention here ... Sofaliok, yesterday, is talking about the world, the Arabs position is getting weaker and the world position is disintegrating; meanwhile the Director of Russian Military Intelligence is saying that the world is backing the Russian initiative and avoiding military confrontation, so do the Arabs.
Unidentified male	Sir, is his information correct...
Male 2	I told you they are not coordinating their words so we are weighing the Russian position. Here, he is saying that the United States sent a warning to Iraq about the February 16 deadline, what is that? Is that the date of the attack? That is why we would like Iraq's answer to be constructive because in order to achieve the goal, concessions have to be made from both parties meaning this has been coordinated with their foreign ministry but the negotiation was clear in the way they were talking about the others. What is this about America having issued a warning on the 16 th . You don't know anything about it? Do you?
Unidentified Male 1	It is not a warning!!
Unidentified Male 2	The US commander in the area said he needed a week to get ready; this is what was said. It was like four or five days ago, the week ends on the 16, 17, but they are saying that the president did not mention...
Male 2	He says afterwards that the US concentration of troops was to scare us due to what the Russian intelligence told their colleagues in the Iraqi

	intelligence. At that time they did not mention that the troop concentration was to scare you, they said they are expecting an attack and so on. Look at the other contradiction - what did he say after the troop concentration became a reality...the diplomatic efforts are in place he says...that was for scaring you and in anticipation of an attack.
Unidentified Male	The military readiness, Sir, is for an attack.
Male 2	This is military readiness. Do we know the timing?
Unidentified	[Inaudible]
Male 2	I calculate one of their objectives is to get the green light from their command so the timing is not supposed to be known. They want to strain us. This is a possibility and the other one is that when Kofi Annan leaves Iraq and they present their report they will refuse it and before we hear their refusal we might hear the attack.
Unidentified Male	Yes, I am certain that this time they are going to do very delicate intelligence work and guarantee an attack.
Male 1	Sir, the technical attacks are always expected but a comprehensive attack...
Unidentified Male	The comprehensive attack after Kofi Annan leaves Baghdad for New York and the mission failed.
Unidentified Male	Before Kofi Annan arrives and as soon as he leaves the Iraqi Air space...
Male 1	He is going to tell them while he is in Baghdad he is going to let them know.
Unidentified	[Inaudible]
Male 1	Sir, where do we lodge him? At the Jadria palace?
Male 2	The Jadria palace, why the Jadria palace? It is evacuated, where shall we lodge him? Al Kadissiah, what the Al Radwaniya maybe we want to tell him this is one of the palaces.
Male 1	How about lunch or dinner, where do we take him?
Male 2	Why don't we put him in the palace where we lodged Jaber?
Male 1	Al Radwaniya is far from work plus he has a team that accompanies him everywhere he goes, it will become complicated.

Male 2	O.k. take him to lunch [Inaudible] but I don't know, did they cancel the meeting...
Unidentified Male	I prefer...
Unidentified	[Inaudible]
Male 2	There is no need [Inaudible]. Take him to lunch to Al Kadissiah and then take him for tea to [Inaudible].
Male 1	So this is the arrangement we have.
Male 2	We did not continue if you come from the airport the road is going to look long between [Inaudible] the location but if you come around the airport, this is the airport, the airport road will become exactly like this, this is the fence of the airport, this the fence that separates the locations and then a separation between the population meaning exactly behind the wall there is a civilian population, farmers in their homes and lands and so on.
Male 1	The first fence...
Male 2	The road will become longer so they do not have an impression that this is one location. Abed you are going to be with them; explain it to them, these guys are a team or if they are coming by air of course is different that is clear they will get an idea if they come directly to Al Kadissaih from there the picture will be clear. Farmers to the fence and the houses of the citizens and so on and then they get in the compound; this is our policy. You can come in from the expressway and if there is an occasion you have to explain it to them.
Male 1	There is a road from the principal entrance and then we go left where Jaber's house is and after that Al Nasr and then the village.
Male 2	Then from the other road you can go straight to the village.
Unidentified Male	Yes, Sir, to the village.
Male 2	The village is near Bazil al 'Atich, you go parallel to Bazil al 'Atich you go straight this is Bazel al 'Atich and after that you get in the gate of the palace.
Unidentified Male	Yes, sir.

Male 1	I prefer the western side road because if we take this road and go to Al Kadissiah from the citizen's side is long... long... long... it gives an obscure image but if we take the main road and make a left where the house Jaber stayed in and then to Al Nasr the entire location will be in front of you like that we can explain: look this is the wall that is where the population...
Male 2	Between Nasr and the location there is a long road between the fence and you have to explain all of this location, behind it is the population meaning their lands, their homes and so on... the village... the advantage is there.
Unidentified Male	We'll take him to the village, Sir.
Male 2	This is the village.
Unidentified Male	Those coming will have the impression that it is not exaggerated but it will make the discussion easy.
Male 1	I think that the people coming will take a precise picture, they are Austrians and lawyers, they don't have an agenda.
Unidentified Male	From the plane the distance looks closer. Why don't they take a plane then?
Male 2	Yes.
Unidentified Male	A plane, Mr. President, you can see and it is better for explaining, you can show him the wall, that is the principal road, this is the airport wall, and this is a wall between the road and the population.
Male 2	This road is only a road that will lead you to the place without any checkpoints.
Unidentified Male	The road is so the animals do not cross it, so dogs don't get hit and so on. So this wall is a separation between the population and us.
Male 2	The fence won't be visible until he gets to Kadissiah.
Unidentified Male	This, Sir, in two minutes they can see it with their own eyes... [Inaudible]
Male 1	He will see several buildings that they wrote in the report as "offices" meaning offices, Mr. President, not your offices, they are talking about offices where people are planning and working on weapon production and so on and so forth, these are "Chalet".
Male 2	But they are going to see that.

Male 1	We are going to show them so they see they are not offices, they are all houses which have bedrooms.
Male 2	At Al Fares.
Unidentified Male	Yes.
Male 2	At Fao and around it, I want a fence to the lake and after that the fence goes to the hill, there is nothing there, just a Shepard far away.
Unidentified Male	Yes, Sir, the hill.
Male 2	It is empty. There is nothing but the Shepard's house far away, around it...the houses for pilots...when they go to the apartments... this was for the Shepard and the other one for the pilots so they can take breaks. After that there is an area where I have the lambs, I have lambs for slaughter, when the butchers need them they are all there, if there is a need. So the presidential is from the fence to the Fao lake.
Unidentified Male	Yes [Inaudible].
Male 1	Fao palace is not finished.
Unidentified Male	No, it is not.
Male 2	After that you go up to the bridge that is next to the guest palace and to the lake and to the maintenance road that belongs to it, the gate, the fence that will be complete by plane they can see all that.
Male 1	Sir, we have the subject of Emir Nayef that I mentioned to you yesterday, a Saudi got in touch with our Ambassador in Tunisia.
Unidentified male	Mr. Ezat can we excuse ourselves, Sir?
Male 2	You can go, we don't have much left.
Male 1	Emir Nayef told him if you have something, meaning, the Saudi Ambassador tasked a Saudi who works for the Arab Education culture, and science organization, told them Nayef is here, if they need anything.
Male 2	We have to follow the bureaucracy, the Saudi ambassador, let him pick up the phone and call his Iraqi colleague, is there something in this?

Male 1	You want to ignore it?
Male 2	We don't ignore it. We repeat the same position. We don't have anything new and we want our Saudi brothers to understand that if you have an interferer, he is still there, at his leisure, and they are ruling there for seven years. So what is it that is left between us that got you to this point. We don't understand, to this day we tried on several occasions to get in touch with you. Whenever you feel is the appropriate moment to initiate this tie, it is an open ended subject, let it go from the comrade Ali to Nayef.
Male 2	[Inaudible] Comrade Ali was a foreign minister.
Male 1	But he was after the invasion.
Unidentified Male	Yes it will create some friction...Mr. President it doesn't matter in whose name it goes, the important thing is the meaning.
Male 2	Yes, do you want it to go from the command? That I got in touch with Baghdad and passed on the message and the command responded in this manner.
Male 1	Yes. I got in touch with Baghdad and Baghdad responded with no names.
Male 2	Abu Ahmad don't get too comfortable, we are almost done here we are sending cables, we are done
Unidentified	[Inaudible]
Male 2	Ok, goodbye. Yesterday I wrote a letter to the comrades, I did not tell you about it [Inaudible] Comrade Ali is present, they notified Comrade Latif and they read it to the people and they explained the content to the members of the command [Inaudible]. It is only addressed to the official branches, the members of the bureaus, national bureaus and so on, the branches will read it to the members of peoples command, the topic is women and training. Yesterday...
Unidentified male	I wrote a letter discussing...
Male 2	What are they doing? The women are going to get trained. There will be professionals in charge of the training.
Unidentified male	The media...[Inaudible].
